Renato Rapada Among Graduates at RVUCOM's Commencement Ceremony

He will complete his residency program in Emergency Medicine at San Antonio Military Medical Center in San Antonio, Texas. Dr. Rapada is the son of Renato and Ruth Rapada. He is a graduate of Dr. Ronald E. McNair Academic High School. He attended Johns Hopkins University where he earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in Molecular Biophysics.



During his time at RVUCOM, Dr. Rapada served as a National Board Member of the Student Association of Military Osteopathic Physicians and Surgeons (SAMOPS). Also, his research in military medicine was published in the Journal of Special Operations Medicine.
